At Multicultural Australia, we believe that everyone deserves to live in a safe, welcoming community and be empowered to become economically independent - ParentsNext is an important step towards achieving these goals.

If you're a parent with kids under the age of six living in one of our supported regional areas, you may be eligible to join ParentsNext, a pre-employment program that helps parents and carers plan and prepare for their future before their youngest child starts school.

How does the program work?

Our ParentsNext program provides the opportunity to develop skills and confidence that enables you to become employment ready.

What we offer:

- Support to set study and work goals
- Education support
- Driving lessons
- Volunteering opportunities
- Employment opportunities
- Referrals to community services
- Parenting and personal development courses

How do I become eligible for ParentsNext?

ParentsNext is a free support program available to eligible parents, preparing them for meaningful work.

To be eligible for the program clients will need to:

- Receive Parenting Payment through Centrelink
- Have a child under the age of six
- Live in one of the areas, or surrounds, listed below.
